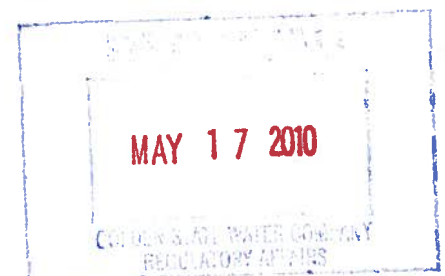

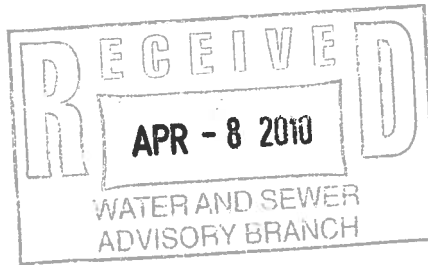

**Subject:** *Supply Expense Offset - Region II*

### Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to offset the net increase in supply costs for purchased electricity, purchased water, and pump taxes in the Region II service area. The total proposed increase, including uncollectibles and franchise fees, is \$13,288,321 or 11.97%. GSWC is requesting that a surcharge be applied to all metered sales in Region II.

**Background**

Purchased electricity in the Region II service area is obtained from Southern California Edison. Southern California Edison had a rate change on January 1, 2010 that resulted in a decrease in purchased electricity costs of \$305,949.

Purchased water in the Region II service area is obtained from the City of Cerritos, the City of Paramount, the City of Hawthorne, the City of South Gate, the City of Inglewood, California Water Service, Central Basin MWD, West Basin MWD, and Suburban Water Systems. On January 1, 2008, the City of Cerritos increased their water rates. As of January 1, 2010, Central Basin MWD, West Basin MWD, and California Water Service increased their water rates. The total purchased water cost increased by \$12,188,403.

Replenishment Water in the Region II service area is obtained from the Water Replenishment District. On July 1, 2010, the Water Replenishment District increased their rates for pump taxes resulting in an increase of \$1,211,991.

As shown in the workpapers, an increase of \$13,288,321 or 11.97% is needed to offset the net supply costs increase in Region II. A copy of the tariffs (or monthly bills with the new rate circled) is included in the workpapers provided to Commission Staff.

**RATE IMPACT**

The monthly bill of a residential customer on Schedule No. ME-1-R with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter using 12 Ccfs would increase by \$5.53 or 11.64% from \$47.47 to \$52.99.

The monthly bill of a non-residential customer on Schedule No. ME-1-NR with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter using 51 Ccfs would increase by \$ 21.39 or 14.78% from \$144.79 to \$166.18.

**EXISTING RATES**

The present rates in Region II became effective March 21, 2010 by Advice Letter No. 1380-W.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

GSWC requests that the effective date of these revised tariffs shall be April 14, 2010. These tariff sheets are to be approved by the Commission's Division of Water and Audits.

**TIER DESIGNATION**

Pursuant to D. 07-01-024, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

**PROTEST AND RESPONSES**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A

protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B. GSWC will notify its customers of this rate increase by placing a message on the first water bill after the increase is granted.

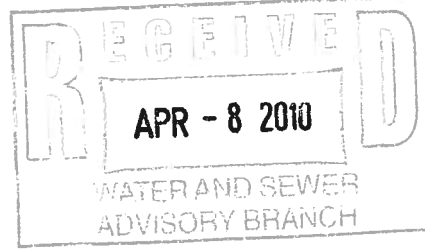
