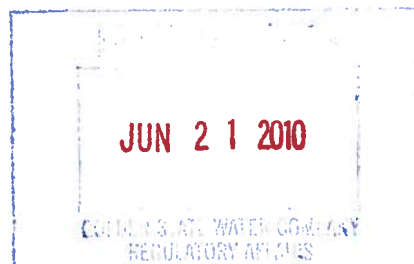

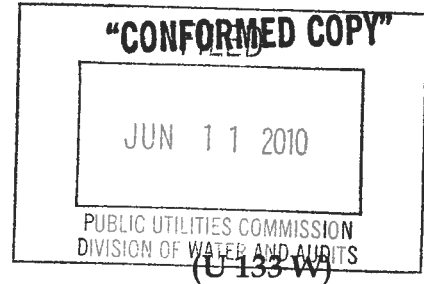

SUBJECT: *Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account*

SUPPLEMENT

This supplemental filing is being made to revise Advice Letter 1399-W as a result of the Division of Water and Audits' staff review. Advice Letter 1399-WA is being filed to change the effective date of the Operation Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account from November 23, 2009, as requested in the original advice letter filing, to November 21, 2008. The November 21, 2008 effective date is consistent with the directives in D. 10-04-030 and is the effective date of D.08-11-057, as mentioned in Ordering Paragraph no. 5 in D.10-04-030. This supplemental filing will replace Advice Letter 1399-W in its entirety.

PURPOSE

In compliance with the California Public Utilities Commission's ("Commission") Decision ("D.") 10-04-030, GSWC submits this advice letter to revise its Preliminary Statements to add Part KK, to reflect the establishment and implementation of the Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account ("OEEPMA").

BACKGROUND

D.10-04-030 issued on April 8, 2010, provided for the establishment of a memorandum account to track costs for participating in the Operational Energy Efficiency Program with Southern California Edison and Pacific Gas and Electric.

On November 21, 2008, the Commission issued D. 08-11-057, which approved 13 operational energy efficiency projects for several Class A and B water utilities at a budget of \$1.33 million. D.08-11-057 modified the original energy efficiency decision (D.07-12-050), which authorized various energy and gas utility pilot programs and studies to be undertaken by water utilities. However, D. 07-12-050 only provided funding for programs with state and municipal operated water entities and did not provide funding for any OEEP projects undertaken by Commission-regulated water utilities. Subsequently, D.07-12-050 was modified in D.08-11-057 to grant funding of 13 OEEP projects proposed by Commission-regulated water utilities.

On November 23, 2009, the California Water Association ("CWA"), on behalf of Alco Water Service Company, California-American Water Company, California Water Service Company, Golden State Water Company, San Jose Water Company, and East Pasadena Water Company, petitioned jointly with Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") and Southern California Edison Company ("SCE") to modify D.08-11-057. The petition sought authority for updated budgets, start dates, cost sharing, recognition of incremental administrative cost support for water and energy utilities, and an OEEP memorandum account for each water utility to track OEEP related costs and payments from energy utilities. On April 8, 2010, the Commission approved the petition and issued D.10-04-030. The Decision orders GSWC to establish an Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account via a Tier 2 Advice Letter.

Specifically, Ordering Paragraphs 5 thru 7 in D.10-04-030 state the following,

5. *Alco Water Service Company, California-American Water Company, California Water Service Company, Golden State Water Company, San Jose Water Company, and East Pasadena Water Company are each authorized to establish an Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account to track its costs and payments from Southern California Edison Company and Pacific Gas and Electric Company associated with Operational Energy Efficiency Programs approved in this Decision and Decision 08-11-057.*
6. *Alco Water Service Company, California-American Water Company, California Water Service Company, Golden State Water Company, San Jose Water Company, and East Pasadena Water Company shall each file an advice letter within 30 days from the effective date of this Decision under Tier 2 of General Order 96-B to establish an Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account. Any interested party may protest an advice letter filing, as provided for in General Order 96-B. If a substantially similar Memorandum Account has already been authorized by Division of Water and Audits, the advice letter shall request that such Memorandum Account be renamed the Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account, and such modification shall not alter the effective date of the renamed Memorandum Account.*
7. *Each of Alco Water Service Company, California-American Water Company,*

California Water Service Company, Golden State Water Company, San Jose Water Company, and East Pasadena Water Company, in its Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account, may record its Operational Energy Efficiency Program costs incurred and shall record all Operational Energy Efficiency Program payments received from Southern California Edison Company and Pacific Gas and Electric Company on or after the effective date of this Decision or the effective date of its Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account, whichever is earlier.

The OEEPMA will be interest bearing and will track OEEP related project costs, OEEP-related administrative costs, and OEEP reimbursement payments from PG&E and SCE.

MEMORANDUM ACCOUNT TREATMENT

GSWC is aware that a memorandum account is not a guarantee of eventual recovery of expenses, nor is it carried as a regular account under the uniform system of accounts for water utilities. It is carried "off the books" as a memorandum account. Further, it is also known that Commission policy on memorandum account treatment has always been that the burden of proof of the reasonableness of expenses charged to the account is the responsibility of the utility requesting reimbursement of such expenses.

REVISIONS TO PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

GSWC proposes to revise its Preliminary Statement to include Part KK, Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account. The purpose of the OEEPMA is to record OEEP-related costs and OEEP reimbursement payments from PG&E and SCE.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to D.10-04-030 and D. 07-01-024, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation and requests that the OEEP Memorandum Account be made effective November 21, 2008, which is the date of issuance of D. 08-11-057.

PROTEST AND RESPONSES

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;

- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:


If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact this person at 909-394-3600 ext. 682.

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

KK. Operational Energy Efficiency Program Memorandum Account ("OEEPMA")

1. Purpose

The purpose of the OEEPMA is to track the Operational Energy Efficiency project costs incurred by Golden State Water Company and OEEP-related reimbursements from Pacific Gas and Electric and Southern California Edison Company.

2. Applicability

The OEEPMA applies to the Bay Point District and the Region III Service Territory

3. Accounting Procedure

The OEEPMA does not have a rate component.

Golden State Water Company shall track all OEEP-related costs paid by Golden State Water Company, including expenses, capital investment (including carrying costs associated with capital investment), outside contractors/consultants, software, and Administrative support. OEEP-administrative support is shared equally between California -American Water Company, California Water Service, Golden State Water Company, and San Jose Water Company. Golden State Water Company shall also track any reimbursement for OEEP-related costs paid by Pacific Gas and Electric Company or Southern California Edison Company.

GSWC shall maintain the OEEPMA by making entries at the end of each month as follows:

- a. A debit entry shall be made to the OEEPMA at the end of each month to record the expenses discussed above.
- b. A credit entry shall be made to the OEEPMA at the end of each month to record the OEEP -related reimbursements from Pacific Gas and Electric and Southern California Edison.
- c. Interest shall accrue to the OEEPMA on a monthly basis by applying a rate equal to one-twelfth of the 3-month Commercial Paper Rate, as reported in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, to the average of the beginning-of-month and the end-of-month balances.

4. Effective Date

The OEEPMA effective date shall be November 21, 2008.

5. Disposition

Disposition of amounts recorded in the OEEPMA shall be determined in GSWC's next General Rate Case.
