

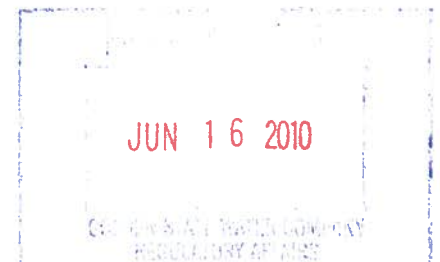

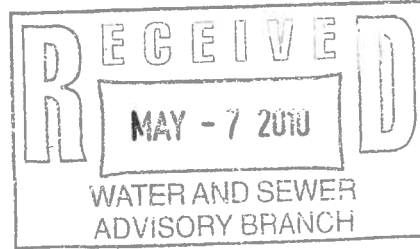

Subject: Temporary Surcharge Request

Summary

This advice letter is requesting approval to amortize the cumulative balance in the California Alternate Rates for Water (CARW) Balancing Account, pursuant to Decision No. 07-11-037.

Request

GSWC is seeking authorization to impose a temporary surcharge in its Region II service territory to amortize the cumulative undercollected balance in its CARW Balancing Account. As of December 31, 2009, the under-collection was \$2,683,357 or 2.42% of adopted

gross revenues. This filing is in compliance with Section 11.01 of the Settlement Agreement in Decision No. 07-11-037, dated November 16, 2007. GSWC is seeking to implement a temporary surcharge of \$0.09298 per Ccf in Tier 1, \$0.10693 per Ccf in Tier 2 for residential metered customers and \$0.08471 per Ccf for non-residential customers for a 12-month period to recover the undercollection.

Background

On September 21, 2000, GSWC filed Application 00-09-048 for authority to establish a low income rate for residential customers in its Region II service territory. On January 9, 2002, the Commission issued Decision 02-01-034 which authorized GSWC to implement the CARW program in its Region II service territory.

The California Alternate Rate for Water (CARW) is a ratepayer-funded program that provides eligible low-income customers a 15% discount on their water bill. Customers must meet the following qualifying criteria: (1) water account is classified as residential (2) housing unit is either a single family dwelling or duplex with separate water meters and (3) the required household income is met.

GSWC is filing this advice letter in accordance with Section 11.01 of the Settlement Agreement in Decision No. 07-11-037, which states,

GSWC requested recovery of the accumulated balance of the cost of its low income program in Region II through a rate surcharge. As of December 31, 2005 the balance was \$1,310,645. DRA did not address this item in their report, but following discussions between the parties it was agreed that when the balance reaches 2% of adopted Region II revenues GSWC is permitted to file an advice letter to recover the accumulated balance through a surcharge.

GSWC is proposing a surcharge of \$0.09298 per Ccf in Tier 1, \$0.10693 per Ccf in Tier 2, for metered customers on Schedules No. ME-1-R and \$0.08471 per Ccf for non-residential customers on Schedule ME-1-NR. The temporary surcharge would be in effect for a 12-month period beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1400-W.

Rate Impact

The monthly bill of a residential customer on Schedule No. ME-1-R with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter using 12 Ccf would increase during the 12-month amortization period by \$1.12 or 2.35% from \$47.47 to \$48.58.

The monthly bill of a non-residential customer on Schedule No. ME-1-NR with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter using 51 Ccf would increase during the 12-month amortization period by \$4.32 or 2.98% from \$144.79 to \$149.11.

Two copies of detailed workpapers supporting the proposed rate increase and rate calculations are being supplied to the Commission Staff under a separate cover.

Tier designation

Pursuant to D. 07-01-024, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Effective date

GSWC is requesting that this filing become effective within 10 days from the filing date.

Protest And Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact this person at 909-394-3600.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B. GSWC will notify its customers of this rate increase by placing a message on the first water bill after the increase is granted.

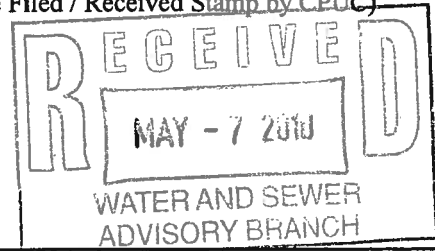
