**Subject: Temporary Surcharge Request****Summary**

This advice letter requests amortization of the cumulative balance of \$2,434,106 or 2.48% recorded in the California Alternate Rates for Water ("CARW") Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2009. This request is made pursuant to Standard Practice U-27, Section D.39. which states:

39. *Reserve account amortization for Class A utilities will be part of the General Rate Case or may be by advice letter when the account over or under collection exceeds 2%, at the utility's option.*<sup>1</sup>

**Background**

On November 27, 2006 GSWC filed Advice Letter 1232-W requesting recovery of the balance in the CARW balancing account as of December 2004. GSWC was allowed to recover the balance in the balancing account pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 5N from D. 06-11-020 which states the following:

*SCWC raised the matter of its CARW balancing account in prepared testimony, seeking authorization to recover in a surcharge both the balance that had accumulated in the account and the ongoing costs of the program. (Exhibit 10, pp. 1 - 2 (Keith Switzer/SCWC).) The balance in the account as of December 2004 was \$744,111. (Exhibit 10, p. 3 (Keith Switzer/SCWC).) SCWC also proposed to continue recording the costs of the CARW program in the balancing account in order to have the flexibility to adjust the CARW program if that became necessary in the future. (Exhibit 10, p. 4 (Keith Switzer/SCWC).) ORA stated in its testimony that it agreed with the proposal to recover the \$744,111 already incurred and recorded in the CARW balancing account, but it disagreed with the proposed additional surcharge to recover the on-going costs of the program. (Exhibit 41, pp. 11-4 to 11-5 (Victor Chan/ORR).) ORR also recommended that SCWC continue to record the CARW program costs in the existing balancing account and seek recovery in the next GRC if there is no statewide program enacted by that time. In its testimony ORR did not agree to recovery of the updated December 2005 balance...*

Advice Letter 1232-W was approved on January 1, 2007.

### **The CARW Program**

GSWC's CARW program offers a 15% reduction on the water bill to customers that meet the following qualifying criteria: (1) water account is classified as residential (2) housing unit is either a single family dwelling or duplex with separate water meters and (3) household income requirement is met. To participate in the CARW program, customers must submit an application and eligibility declaration on a Commission-approved form. After the application is submitted, reviewed, and accepted, the customer's next water bill will reflect the 15% reduction. The CARW customer will receive the full 15% reduction on the next water bill regardless of when the application is approved, there is no prorate.

### **Request**

The purpose of this filing is to increase the water rates in Region III by \$2,434,106 or 2.48% to amortize the cumulative balance recorded in the Region III CARW Balancing Account, for the period of January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2009. GSWC is seeking to implement a temporary surcharge of \$0.07724 per Ccf in Tier 1, \$0.08883 per Ccf in Tier 2 for residential metered customers on Schedule No. R3-1-R and \$0.06879 per Ccf for non-residential customers on Schedule No. R3-1-NR to recover the under-collection. The temporary surcharge would be in effect for a 12-month period beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1401-W.

### **Rate Impact**

The monthly bill of a residential customer on Schedule No. R3-1-R with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter using 17 Ccf would increase during the 12-month amortization period by \$1.32 or 2.69% from \$49.31 to \$50.63.

The monthly bill of a non-residential customer on Schedule No. R3-1-NR with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter using 85 Ccf would increase during the 12-month amortization period by \$5.85 or 3.22% from \$181.87 to \$187.71.

### **Tier designation**

Pursuant to D. 07-01-024, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

### **Effective date**

GSWC is requesting that this filing become effective upon regular statutory notice.

### **Protest And Responses**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;

- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact this person at 909-394-3600.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be

entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B. GSWC will notify its customers of this rate increase by placing a message on the first water bill after the increase is granted.

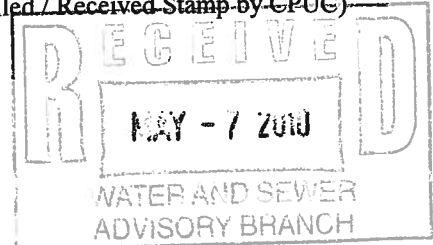
