

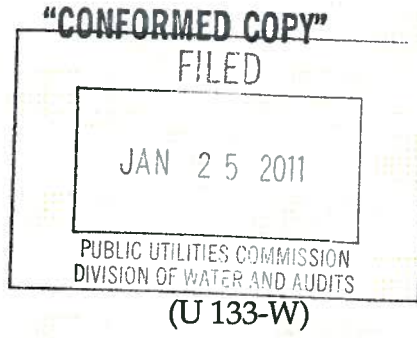

**Subject: *Region I CARW Balancing Account Amortization***

**SUMMARY**

This advice letter requests the refund of the cumulative overcollection balance of \$845,293 recorded in the Region I California Alternate Rates for Water ("CARW") Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2010. This request is made pursuant to Section 12.00 in the Settlement Agreement for Decision No. ("D.") 10-12-059, dated December 16, 2010. The specific language states:

*The Parties agree that GSWC can implement a balancing account to record all surcharge revenues and costs related to the implementation and administration of the LIRA program. The balancing account will accrue interest at the 90-day commercial paper rate. Necessary adjustments to the surcharge will be made in the general rate cases or in an Advice Letter if any significant over/under-collection is evident.*

*GSWC agrees to provide an annual summary report of the LIRA program to the Commission's Water Division and DRA, and to continue program review in its future general rate cases. The annual summary report will contain the status of the program including an accounting of benefits provided and surcharges collected, evaluation of costs, participation level, proposed improvements to the program, as well as the status of the balancing account.*

*Parties agree to file for amortization of the residual balance via an advice letter filing within 30 days after the effective date of CARW program for this GRC.*

**COMPLIANCE**

The effective date of the Region I CARW Program is January 1, 2011, therefore the deadline for this advice letter filing is January 30, 2011.

**REQUEST**

The purpose of this filing is to decrease the water rates in Region I by \$845,293 or 1.66% to amortize the cumulative overcollection balance recorded in the Region I CARW Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2010. GSWC is seeking to implement a temporary surcredit of \$0.05462 per Ccf for metered customers and \$0.86 per customer, per month for flat-rate customers to refund the entire overcollection to Region I customers. The temporary surcredits would be in effect for a 12-month period beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1433-W.

Supporting workpapers for the Region I CARW Balancing Account are being supplied to the California Public Utilities Commission's Division of Water and Audits for review.

**TIER DESIGNATION**

Pursuant to D. 10-12-059, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

GSWC is requesting that this filing become effective on February 24, 2011.

**PROTEST AND RESPONSES**

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:


If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact this person at 909-394-3600 ext. 682.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in Decision 04-03-039, all bills are subject to a surcredit of \$0.0788 per Ccf for a 9-year amortization period, beginning May 6, 2004 on the effective date of Advice Letter 1150-W. This surcredit will refund the ratepayer portion of the revenues collected from the City of Folsom for the period of July 1, 1994 through March 16, 2004.
4. Pursuant to Decision 05-07-045, to recover the balance as of January 31, 2005 in the Water Quality Litigation Memorandum Account, a surcharge of \$0.155 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for 20 years. 8. As authorized by the California Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.080 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate through April 29, 2011, 12-month from the effective date of Advice Letter 1392-WA on April 30, 2010. This surcharge will recover the WRAM/MCBA Balancing Accounts as of December 31, 2009.
9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, \$0.05462 per Ccf is to be credited to the Quantity Rate for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1433-W. This credit will refund the over-collection in the CARW Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2010. CARW customers are exempt from this credit. (N)

This credit is to refund the MCBA Balancing Accounts as of December 31, 2009.
8. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a credit of \$0.86 per month is to be applied to flat rate bills for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1433-W. This credit will refund the overcollection in the CARW Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2010. CARW customers are exempt from this credit. (N)
