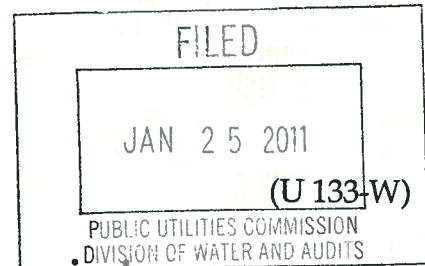

Subject: *Region I Supply Expense Balancing Account Amortization*

SUMMARY

This advice letter requests the amortization of the cumulative undercollection recorded in the Region I Supply Expense Balancing Accounts. This request is made pursuant to Section 12.05 in the Settlement Agreement for Decision No. ("D.") 10-12-059, dated December 16, 2010. The specific language states:

12.05 Supply Cost Balancing Accounts Review and Amortization – GSWC requested review and approval to amortize the Supply Cost Balancing Accounts in its Region 1 CSAs (excluding Simi Valley12), as of August 31, 2009. DRA

reviewed GSWC's calculation of the balancing accounts and determined that they had been maintained in accordance with the Commission's 1983 procedures for determining accruals in incremental balancing accounts.

The table below shows the amounts to be amortized:

COMPLIANCE

All of the Supply Expense undercollection balances are below the 5% threshold, therefore, the amortization in each customer service area listed above will be in place for a 12-month period.

REQUEST

The purpose of this filing is to amortize the Supply Expense Balancing Accounts in the Region I customer service areas, pursuant to the Settlement Agreement in D. 10-12-059. GSWC is seeking to implement temporary surcharges in each Region I customer service area, except for Simi Valley, to recover the entire undercollection. The temporary surcharges will be in effect for a 12-month period, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1434-W.

Supporting workpapers for the Region I Supply Expense Balancing Accounts and the amortization calculations are being supplied to the California Public Utilities Commission's Division of Water and Audits for review.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to D. 10-12-059, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

EFFECTIVE DATE

GSWC is requesting that this filing become effective on February 24, 2011.

PROTEST AND RESPONSES

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A

protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact this person at 909-394-3600 ext. 682.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B.

2. Service with 5/8 x 3/4-inch meters and 3/4-inch meters is available only to customers served with 5/8 x 3/4-inch and 3/4-inch meters as of May 31, 1995.
3. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in Decision 04-03-039, all bills are subject to a surcredit of \$0.0788 per Ccf for a 9-year amortization period, beginning May 6, 2004 on the effective date of Advice Letter 1150-W. This surcredit will refund the ratepayer portion of the revenues collected from the City of Folsom for the period of July 1, 1994 through March 16, 2004.
4. Pursuant to Decision 05-07-045, to recover the balance as of January 31, 2005 in the Water Quality Litigation Memorandum Account, a surcharge of \$0.155 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for 20 years. The surcharge amount will be recalculated once in every rate cycle, or more frequently if in any year the receipt of Water Availability Fee (WAF) monies will permit a reduction of \$0.50 or more in the monthly bill under Tariff AC-2.
5. Pursuant to Decision No. 10-12-059, a surcharge of \$0.033 per Ccf will be applied to all metered Customer bills excluding customers that are receiving the CARW credit. This surcharge will offset the CARW credits and CARW administrative program costs recorded in the CARW Balancing Account.

As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.0335 per Ccf is to be added to the Quantity Rate until the balance in the "WCMA" is fully recovered, approximately 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1352-WA, which is October 2, 2010. This surcharge will recover the net revenue loss as a result of the Governor's declared drought on June 4, 2008
8. As authorized by the California Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.080 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate through April 29, 2011, 12-month from the effective date of Advice Letter 1392-WA on April 30, 2010. This surcharge will recover the WRAM/MCBA Balancing Accounts as of December 31, 2009.
9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, \$0.05462 per Ccf is to be credited to the Quantity Rate for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1433-W. This credit will refund the over collection in the CARW Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2010. CARW customers are exempt from this credit.
10. As authorized by the California Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.01307 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a 12-month period, from the effective date of Advice Letter 1434-W. This surcharge will recover the undercollection in the Supply Expense Balancing Account. (N)

This credit is to refund the MCBA Balancing Accounts as of December 31, 2009.
8. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a credit of \$0.86 per month is to be applied to flat rate bills for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1433-W. This credit will refund the overcollection in the CARW Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2010. CARW customers are exempt from this credit.
9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcharge of \$0.46 per month is to be applied to flat rate bills for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1434-W. This surcharge will recover the undercollection in the Supply Expense Balancing Account. (N)

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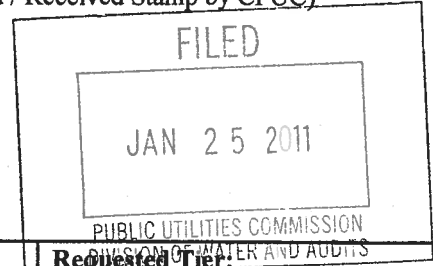
