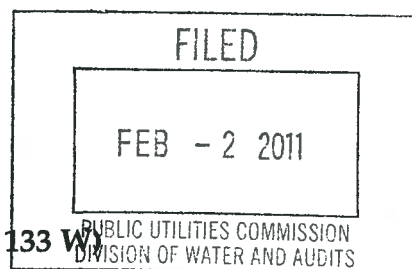

SUBJECT: *Revise the Preliminary Statement to include the General Office Maintenance Memorandum Account*

PURPOSE

The purpose of this filing is to revise GSWC's Preliminary Statements to include the General Office Maintenance Memorandum Account ("GOMMA"). GSWC needs to establish the GOMMA to track costs related to its remedial efforts to renovate and repair recently detected damage caused by water and moisture to GSWC's General Office. These efforts include the exploration, detection, and examination for water and moisture damage as well as all necessary renovation and repair of the damage throughout GSWC's General Office building ("General Office") located in San Dimas, California.

BACKGROUND

On January 9, 2011, GSWC conducted a building examination to determine whether there was possible damage caused by water and moisture in four locations in its General Office. The independent examination confirmed the presence of such damage to the building in the four locations. GSWC is expanding its scope of the areas of the building to be examined to determine how widespread the water and moisture damage is in its General Office. In order to do that, GSWC has requested further independent examination of other areas of the building beyond the original four locations. Depending on the results of the additional examination, GSWC will consider the best recommended remedial actions from its contractor(s) to ensure that all actual or potential problems arising from the water and

moisture damage are mitigated and rectified. GSWC is reviewing and researching its property insurance policies, and will submit a claim for any covered damage. Additionally, if GSWC receives any payment(s) from its insurer, it will be credited to the GOMMA.

To date, GSWC has incurred approximately \$11,000 in costs. GSWC plans to record all costs associated with its remedial actions in the GOMMA.

REQUEST

GSWC is seeking this memorandum account to track its incremental administrative expenses associated with the exploration, detection, and examination for water and moisture damage as well as all necessary renovation and repair of the damage throughout GSWC's General Office building located in San Dimas, California.

EXPENSES

GSWC believes that it will incur costs that should be captured in the GOMMA. These costs include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a) Costs for contractors to explore, detect, and examine for water and moisture damage in the General Office;
- b) Costs to renovate and repair the building due to the damage;
- c) Costs for the monitoring and maintenance of the renovated and repaired areas of the building; and
- d) Costs to temporarily relocate employees, if it is determined to be necessary, until the required renovations and repairs are completed.

REQUEST TO ESTABLISH A MEMORANDUM ACCOUNT

In accordance with the Commission Standard Practice U-27-W, GSWC requests to establish a memorandum account to track the aforementioned unanticipated costs.

These costs are of an exceptional nature for GSWC. GSWC believes it will incur costs to explore, detect, and examine for water and moisture damage as well as to renovate and repair the damage to its General Office building located in San Dimas, California.

GSWC must expend all reasonable and necessary costs to ensure that all actual or potential problems arising from the water and moisture damage are mitigated and rectified.

The costs being addressed here are caused by an event of an exceptional nature that is not under the utility's control and the required expenditures were unforeseen and are not in the existing rates.

These costs could not have been reasonably foreseen in GSWC's last General Rate Case ("GRC") and will occur prior to GSWC's next scheduled GRC. GSWC may jeopardize full recovery of the costs discussed above by waiting until its next scheduled GRC filing.

GSWC anticipates that it will incur substantial costs employing independent consultants and contractors for the examination, renovation, repair, and maintenance of any water and moisture damage until it has been completely and fully rectified and remedied.

GSWC customers will benefit from the establishment of this memo account. Before recovery is granted, the expenses tracked in the memo account goes through a prudency review by the Division of Ratepayer Advocates and the Commission Division of Water and Audits to make sure the company did not spend money without discretion. Because of this clear benefit, GSWC's request meets U-27 W's fifth criterion.

MEMORANDUM ACCOUNT TREATMENT

GSWC is aware that a memorandum account is not a guarantee of eventual recovery of expenses, nor is it carried as a regular account under the uniform system of accounts for water utilities. It is carried "off the books" as a memorandum account. Further, it is also known that the California Public Utilities Commission policy on memorandum account treatment has always been that the burden of proof of the reasonableness of expenses charged to the account is the responsibility of the utility requesting reimbursement of such expenses.

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to D. 07-01-024, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation. GSWC is requesting that this advice letter have an effective date of December 9, 2010, the first date of examination for any damage, and thereafter more aggressive remedial treatment planning started.

PROTEST AND RESPONSES

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;

- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate a statute(s) or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:


If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact this person at 909-394-3600 ext. 682.

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

SS. GENERAL OFFICE MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM ACCOUNT

(N)

1. Purpose

The purpose of the General Office Maintenance Memorandum Account ("GOMMA") is to track costs related to remedial efforts to renovate and repair recently detected damage caused by water and moisture to GSWC's General Office. These efforts include the exploration, detection, and examination for water and moisture damage as well as all necessary renovation and repair of the damage throughout GSWC's General Office building located in San Dimas, California.

The GOMMA shall include all GOMMA-related costs paid by GSWC including, but not limited to, costs for contractors to explore, detect, and examine for water and moisture damage in the General Office; costs to renovate and repair the building due to the damage; costs for the monitoring and maintenance of the renovated and repaired areas of the building; and costs to temporarily relocate employees, if it is determined to be necessary, until the required renovations and repairs are completed.

GSWC will apply (credit) any GOMMA-related insurance payments it receives to the GOMMA.

2. Applicability

The GOMMA does not have a rate component.

GSWC shall maintain the GOMMA by making entries at the end of each month as follows:

- a. A debit entry shall be made to the GOMMA at the end of each month to record the expenses.
- b. A debit entry equal to interest on the balance in the account at the beginning of the month and half the balance after the above entry (a.), at a rate equal to one-twelfth of the rate on three month Commercial Paper, as reported in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, H.15 or its successor.

3. Effective Date

The GOMMA shall have the effective date of December 9, 2010.

4. Disposition

GSWC may seek rate recovery of the GOMMA in its next general rate case or through a Tier 3 advice letter filing.

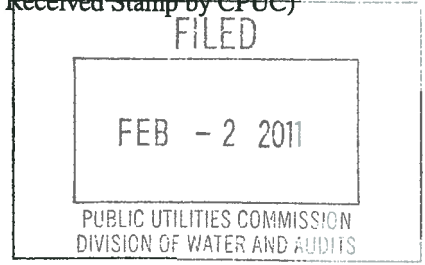
