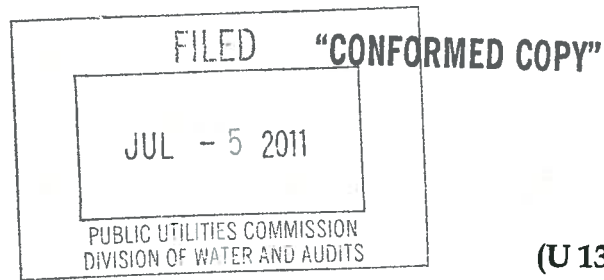

Subject: *Sample Form update*

Request

In compliance with Decision No. 11-05-020, GSWC hereby submits this advice letter to update its California Alternate Rates for Water ("CARW") sample form, Form No. 20.

Background

On December 17, 2009, the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") opened Rulemaking No. 09-12-017 to determine whether sharing of qualifying low-income customer information between regulated water and energy utilities should be required and whether sharing of this information between regulated water and municipal energy utilities should be encouraged to increase enrollment in water and energy low-income assistance programs.

On April 1, 2010, the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") issued a ruling and scoping memo requesting comments on low-income customer information sharing among water and energy utilities, including the use of categorical eligibility, and proposed guidelines. Comments were submitted on April 23, 2010 by California Water Association¹ ("CWA"); Division of Ratepayer Advocates ("DRA"); Joint Consumers (National Consumer Law Center, Disability Rights Advocates and The Utility Reform Network); two sets of Joint Utilities, one set is Southern California Edison ("SCE") and Pacific Gas and Electric ("PG&E"), and the other set is San Diego Gas & Electric Company ("SDG&E") and SoCalGas; PacifiCorp d.b.a. Pacific Power ("PacifiCorp"); Park Water Company ("Park"); and Southwest Gas Corporation ("Southwest").

On May 5, 2011, the Commission issued Decision No. ("D.") 11-05-020 in Rulemaking No.

09-12-017. D. 11-05-020 requires water and energy utilities with overlapping service territories to share low-income customer information to increase the participation rates in water low-income assistance programs. D.11-05-020 also encourages water and municipal utilities to share low-income customer information and water and energy utilities to collaborate on outreach efforts to low-income customers. Automatic enrollment of eligible customers will occur as the result of maximizing the effectiveness of information sharing; however, an opt-out notification is required should the customer decline to be automatically enrolled in the water utility's low-income assistance program. Water utilities should automatically enroll customers only if the programs' income and eligibility requirements are comparable. Data sharing guidelines are adopted that incorporate these directives and establish procedures for handling confidential customer data and unauthorized disclosure of such data.

Water utilities were ordered to add customer consent (authorization) language to their existing low income program enrollment applications. The energy utilities already have consent language in their low income program applications.

Attachment 1, item 1 in D.11-05-020 states,

11. Regulated water utilities must obtain customer authorization from all customers, both current and new, to share Confidential Customer Data by including a declaration statement on both 1) the low income assistance program application; and 2) the re-certification and random post-enrollment verification forms; that reads as follows:

"I understand that [insert regulated water utility name] can share my information with other utilities or their agents to enroll me in their assistance programs."

Compliance

GSWC is revising its Form No. 20 to add language regarding the sharing of customer information with the energy utilities for the purposes of automatic CARW enrollment, as ordered in D.11-05-020.

Additionally, GSWC is requesting to remove Form No. 23, California Alternate Rates for Water. Form No. 23 was created for Region I exclusively because the Region I CARW customer discount was designed as a flat rate discount. Form No. 20 was created for Regions II and III and its CARW discount was designed to be calculated based on the total water bill amount (volumetrically driven). In Decision No. 10-11-035, dated November 19, 2010, the Commission authorized GSWC to implement a flat rate CARW discount in Regions II and III and increase the income qualification guideline from 175% to 200% Federal Poverty Level, which matches the Region I CARW program. As such, all three regions now have identical CARW qualifying income levels and offer a flat rate CARW discount. There is no longer a need to have two CARW forms (one serving Regions II and III and one serving Region I). Form No. 23 is being cancelled and Form

No. 20 will now serve all three regions.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to D. 07-01-024, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Effective Date

GSWC requests approval of this advice letter allowing these tariffs to become effective July 5, 2011.

Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:


If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact this person at 909-394-3600 ext. 682.

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

GOLDEN STATE WATER COMPANY NOTICE AND APPLICATION FOR CALIFORNIA ALTERNATE RATES FOR WATER (CARW) PROGRAM

Program Description

The California Public Utilities Commission has authorized Golden State Water Company (GSWC) to implement a Low Income Rate Assistance Program to assist low-income families. GSWC's California Alternate Rates for Water (CARW) program provides a flat 15% monthly credit for eligible customers based upon the same income qualification guidelines that are used by the electric and gas California Alternate Rate for Energy (CARE) programs.

If you already participate in the CARE program of participating energy utilities you may also qualify for GSWC's CARW (N) program by submitting a copy of a current utility bill showing your eligibility for CARE. Customers, who do not participate in these programs, can qualify by submitting an application and income verification in accordance with the program guidelines. To obtain an application or for more information please visit our website at www.gswater.com. The CARW (N) program also extends eligibility to customers in mobile homes who receive their water through sub-metered service, non-profit group living facilities, agricultural employee housing facilities and migrant worker housing centers that are enrolled in the CARE programs. The CARW discount becomes effective after your application and proof of income have been verified and approved. **Current customers of GSWC on the CARW Program will be sent an application when it is time for (N) renewal. (N)**

Program Qualifications

- ✓ The GSWC bill must be in your name and the address must be your primary residence or you must be a tenant receiving water service by a sub-metered system in a mobile home park.
- ✓ You may not be claimed as a dependent on another person's tax return.
- ✓ You must reapply each time you move.
- ✓ You must renew your application every two years, or sooner, if requested.
- ✓ You must notify GSWC within 30 days if you become ineligible for CARW.
- ✓ Your total gross annual income of all persons living in your household cannot exceed the income levels below:
