

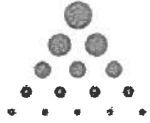

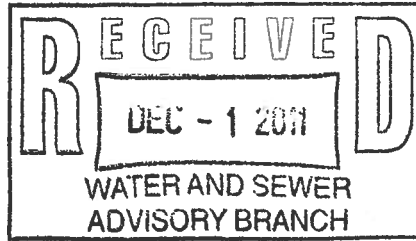

Supplement to Advice Letter 1453-WA, Region 3 (Orange County) Mandatory Conservation Rationing Implementation Memorandum Account Amortization. Resolution No. W-4894, issued on December 1, 2011, approved the tariffs in this advice letter filing. This supplemental filing is being made to add tariff sheet numbers only. There were no other changes made to this filing. This supplemental filing will replace Advice Letter 1453-WA in its entirety.

Purpose

This filing is requesting to amortize the Region 3 (Orange County) Mandatory Conservation Rationing Implementation Memorandum Account ("R3MCRIMA"). The purpose of the R3MCRIMA was to 1.) track the incremental operating and administration costs associated with the implementation of Schedule No. 14.1-OC in the Orange County customer service area, 2.) track the penalty charges, if any, that Municipal Water District of Orange County ("MWDOC") imposed on GSWC for exceeding its allocation, 3.) track the premium charges GSWC imposed on its Orange County customers who exceeded their monthly water allocation, and 4.) track any additional revenues in the form of penalties paid by customers for violating water use restrictions.

GSWC is seeking California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") authorization to refund \$2,078,455 recorded in the R3MCRIMA via surcredits to its Orange County customers. GSWC is requesting to close the R3MCRIMA once the refund has been granted.

Background

On April 14, 2009, the Board of Directors of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California ("MWD Board") approved a reduction of water supplies delivered to its member agencies, effective July 1, 2009. The MWD Board changed from "Condition 2- Water Supply Alert" to "Condition 3- Implement Water Supply Allocation", and implemented the Water Supply Allocation Plan ("WSAP") and allocated its available water supplies to member agencies at a Water Supply Allocation Plan level 2.

MWD reduced MWDOC allocations for the fiscal year 2009/2010. In turn, MWDOC decreased its imported water allocation to its retail customers. MWDOC reduced GSWC's allocation from its historical 2004-2006 average usage. GSWC's local water supply along with MWDOC's allocation of imported water had to match Orange

County customers' water demand. With GSWC's reduced allocation from MWDOC, Orange County customers had to reduce consumption accordingly in order for GSWC to stay within its MWDOC 2009/2010 allocation.

On July 9, 2009, GSWC filed Advice Letter 1339-W to activate Schedule 14.1-OC and the R3MCRIMA in its Orange County customer service area. Advice Letter 1339-W was approved with an effective date of August 1, 2009. GSWC activated Stage 2 of its Rationing Plan in Orange County, a mandatory 6% reduction goal.

On August 31, 2009, GSWC filed Advice Letter 1335-W to establish sub-accounts in the R3MCRIMA for each of the eight customer service areas that make up the Region 3 service territory. This was done in order to record each customer service area's individual activity. Advice Letter 1335-W was approved August 1, 2009, via Resolution W-4781. Orange County was the only Region 3 customer service area that implemented mandatory conservation.

On April 1, 2010, GSWC filed Advice Letter 1383-W to lower the rationing stage from Stage 2 to Stage 1, due to the customers response to GSWC's Advice Letter 1339-W conservation request. GSWC was successful in reducing its projected water supply demand by 14%, which is above the projected amounts requested in Advice letter 1339-W. GSWC made a determination that it could lower the rationing stage in Orange County to Stage 1, a voluntary 6% reduction goal. At Stage 1, customers were still asked to conserve so that GSWC could continue to stay within MWDOC's allocation. GSWC also requested to discontinue the Orange County customer premium penalties. Advice Letter 1383-W was approved and became effective on April 1, 2010.

On May 26, 2011, GSWC filed Advice Letter 1448-W to deactivate the Stage 1 rationing in the Orange County customer service area. This was in response to the April 12, 2011 MWD Board notification to its member agencies, effective April 13, 2011, that the mandatory water restriction was going to be lifted. Lifting the allocation restrictions allowed MWDOC to purchase water without financial penalty. MWDOC responded likewise in the Orange County area and lifted its penalties. Advice Letter 1448-W became effective on May 26, 2011.

Memorandum Account Status

GSWC requests the Commission's approval to refund a total of \$2,078,455 recorded in the R3MCRIMA. The R3MCRIMA tracked (1) any additional revenues (in the form of volumetric penalties from its customers for consumption over their allocations) generated from Schedule No. 14.1 OC; (2) its incremental operating expenses incurred after the date Schedule 14.1 OC was activated; (3) any penalties paid to its water wholesalers; and (4) any additional revenues in the form of penalties paid by customers

for violating water use restrictions. Monthly interest was calculated using the three month non-financial commercial paper rate, as authorized.

GSWC did not incur any penalties from MWDOC. GSWC will refund the entire premium charges collected from Orange County customers minus incremental administration and operating expenses. GSWC is proposing to refund the net premium charges to customers in its Orange County customer service area only. The other seven customer service areas that make up the Region 3 service territory did not implement mandatory conservation.

Supporting workpapers have been supplied to the Division of Water and Audits detailing monthly entries to the R3MCRIMA.

Ratemaking Treatment

GSWC is requesting that \$2,078,455 be amortized in the Orange County customer service area via a surcredit based on equivalent meter size. The surcredits will be applied to each Orange County customer's water bill over two billing cycles.

Rate Impact

An Orange County customer with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter will get a refund totaling \$27.95, as shown in the supporting workpapers.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to D. 07-01-024, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 3 designation. A Commission resolution will be required for disposition of the R3MCRIMA.

Effective Date

As ordered in Resolution W-4894, the tariffs contained in this advice letter filing shall go into effect on December 6, 2011, five days after the effective date of Resolution W-4894.

Notice

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B. GSWC will notify its customers of this proposal by postcard.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

Protests And Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- 1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- 2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- 4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- 6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

6. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. The company shall not be required to install new mains to make this service available.
3. The annual service charge will be paid in advance and bills will be computed and rendered monthly based on the total quantity of water delivered.
4. The customer, when requiring irrigation water, shall notify the Company at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance, indicating the date and hour for commencement of such service.
5. No customer shall be eligible for service under this schedule unless irrigating five (5) or more acres of land for citrus or other commercial crops.
6. Service under this schedule is subordinate to all other service schedule offered in this tariff areas and is subject to interruptions in emergencies or at the Company's discretion. The Company will not be liable for damage occasioned by interruption of service supplied under this schedule.

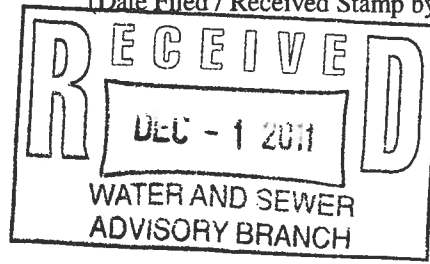
