Subject: 2011 Escalation Year increase for Region III

Purpose

This advice letter requests implementation of the 2011 Escalation Year increase for GSWC's Region III service territory, which was approved in Decision No. (D.) 10-11-035. Specifically, these tariffs are submitted as authorized by Ordering Paragraph No. 12 in the aforementioned decision. Ordering Paragraph 12 states,

- 12. For escalation years 2011 and 2012, Golden State Water Company shall file Tier 1 advice letters in conformance with General Order 96-B proposing new revenue requirements and corresponding revised tariff schedules for each district and rate area in this proceeding. Golden State Water Company's advice letters shall follow the escalation procedures set forth in the Commission's Rate Case Plan (Decision 07-05-062) for Class A Water Utilities and shall include appropriate supporting workpapers. The revised tariff schedules shall take effect on January 1, 2011 and January 1, 2012, respectively and shall apply to service rendered on and after their effective dates. The proposed, revised revenue requirements and rates shall be reviewed by the Commission's Division of Water and Audits. The Division of Water and Audits shall inform the Commission if it finds that the revised rates do not*

conform to the Rate Case Plan, this order, or other Commission decisions, and if so, reject the filing.

Request

GSWC is filing this advice letter to implement rates for Escalation Year 2011. GSWC is authorized to increase rates in its Region III service territory by \$1,480,300 or 1.24% in 2011. The 2011 increase was calculated using the adopted quantities from D.10-11-035 and in accordance with the procedures contained in the Rate Case Plan for Class A utilities (D.07-05-062).

Supporting workpapers showing the calculations of the escalation increase have been provided to Commission staff.

Rate of Return

The following summary lists the recorded, pro-forma, and authorized rates of return in GSWC's Region III district for twelve months ending September 2009. The pro forma rate of return is calculated in accordance with guidelines provided by the DWA.

Existing Rates

The current rates in Region III went into effect on December 1, 2010 through Advice Letter No. 1417-W.

Effective Date

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 12 in D. 10-11-035, the effective date of these revised tariffs shall be January 1, 2011. These tariff sheets are to be approved by the Commission's Division of Water and Audits.

Tier Designation

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 12 in D. 10-11-035, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B.
