Subject: Supplemental to Advice Letter 1437-W, Fire Sprinkler rates for Region II and Region III Customer Service Areas. This supplemental filing is being made to modify the final fire sprinkler rates as a result of the Commission's staff review. This supplemental filing will replace Advice Letter 1437-W in its entirety.

Purpose

This advice letter request to establish Fire Sprinkler rates in its Region II and III customer service areas for customers who require a 1 inch or 2 inch meter that would only require a 3/4 inch meter if they did not have a fire sprinkler system and customers with a 1 ½ inch or 2 inch meter that would only require a 1 inch meter.

Background

In 2006 a memo authorizing Class A Water Utilities to offer a special rate for customers who need a larger meter because they have a sprinkler system was issued by Water Division, this memo authorized Water Utilities to file an advice letter to request a special rate for its customers who need a special fire sprinkler rate to meet local fire requirements.

In Application 08-07-014, GSWC requested Sprinkler System Rates for its Region II and III Customer Service Areas based on a memo from Kevin Coughlan, Director of Water Division, dated January 26, 2006. Using Mr. Coughlan's memo as a guideline, GSWC developed a Fire Sprinkler System Rate for a customer with a 1 inch meter that without fire sprinklers would only require a 5/8 x 3/4-inch meter.

GSWC and DRA settled on this issue and in Decision No. 10-11-035, the Commission adopted the following Sprinkler Service Charges for 2010:

Region II Customer Service Areas Sprinkler Service Charge - \$15.00
Region III Customer Service Areas Sprinkler System Charge -\$16.40

In Application 10-01-009, GSWC requested Sprinkler System Rates for its Region I customer service areas. Again, GSWC relied on Mr. Coughlan's memo. In Region I, GSWC requested Fire Sprinkler System Rates for customers with a 1 inch meter that without fire sprinklers would only require a 5/8 x 3/4 inch meter, for customers with a 1 inch meter that without fire sprinkler would only require a 3/4 inch meter and for customers with a 2 inch meter that without fire sprinklers would only require a 1 inch meter.

GSWC and DRA settled on this issue and in Decision 10-12-059, the Commission adopted the following Sprinkler Service Charges for 2011:

Simi Valley District Sprinkler Service 5/8 x 3/4 inch \$14.10

Los Osos District Sprinkler Service 3/4-inch meter \$33.30
Los Osos District Sprinkler Service 1-inch meter \$59.25

Since these rates have been adopted, customers in GSWC's Regions II and III Customer Service Areas with a 1 inch or 2 inch meter that without fire sprinklers would only require a 3/4 inch meter and customers with a 1 1/2 inch or 2 inch meter that without fire sprinklers would only require a 1 inch meter have requested Fire Sprinkler Service rates.

Request

By this advice letter, GSWC is requesting to establish Fire Sprinkler Rates in its Region II and III Customer Service Areas for customers with a 1 inch or 2 inch meter that without fire sprinklers would only require a 3/4 inch meter and customers with a 1 1/2 or 2 inch meter that without fire sprinklers would only require a 1 inch meter as follows:

Region II District Fire Sprinkler Service 2-inch to 3/4-inch \$26.65
Region II District Fire Sprinkler Service 1 1/2-inch to 1-inch \$37.55
Region II District Fire Sprinkler Service 2-inch to 1-inch \$39.60
Region III District Fire Sprinkler Service 2-inch to 3/4-inch \$28.85
Region III District Fire Sprinkler Service 1 1/2-inch to 1-inch \$40.80
Region III District Fire Sprinkler Service 2-inch to 1-inch \$43.10

The rates were calculated based on the latest settlement between GSWC and DRA in D.10-12-059.

Rate Impact

If approved, the Fire Sprinkler Rates would reduce the rates for customers in GSWC's Regions II and III Customer Service Areas that have a 1 inch or 2 inch meter that without fire sprinklers would only require a 3/4 inch meter and customers with a 1 1/2 inch or 2 inch meter that without fire sprinklers would only require a 1 inch meter.

Effective Date

It is desired that this filing become effective upon CPUC action.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to GO 96-B Water Industry Rule 7.3, this advice letter is being designated as a Tier 2 - New Service Offering.

Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A

protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:


If you have not received a reply to your protest within 10 business days, contact this person at 909-394-3600 ext. 679.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

Subject: Sprinkler System Rates

The Water Division processes customer complaints for water companies when the complaints do not involve impounds for billing disputes. One of the more numerous areas of complaint involves the higher service charge customers have to pay because they need a larger meter solely due to the local requirement for sprinkler systems in homes, while often other districts of the same utility have special rates that take that situation into account, and charge only for the carrying cost of the larger meter. See for example, California Water Service Company's Dixon District.

Our letter of January 18, 1991, "Subject: Rate Design Policy – Service charge allocation by meter size," as reflected in Standard Practice U-7-W, provides the 'service charge ratios' for the rate design of water utilities for the various meter sizes. These ratios were meant to reflect the ability of a water meter to handle demand; that is, they reflect the ability of the meter to provide water under normal conditions. They were not meant to reflect the service charge ratios for meter sizes necessary to reflect demand under rare conditions, such as sprinkler system use. In the opinion of the Water Division, this is a problem that can be easily resolved.

Water utilities can offer new services effective on 30-day statutory notice. Thus you can offer a rate for customers who need a larger meter only because they have sprinkler systems, by advice letter. To be consistent with prior Commission decisions, the rate should include a service charge that reflects the higher carrying charge of the larger meter. Such a filing would provide a fair and equitable service charge for these customers. Fred Curry has an Excel spreadsheet that you can use to calculate the proper service charge for customers who need a larger meter only for sprinkler systems.

Please consider filing an advice letter offering a special rate for customers who need a larger meter only because they have sprinkler systems for all of your districts where the local fire protection agency or building permit department are requiring sprinkler systems in new construction.
