Subject: Rate Base Offset- Arden Cordova and Santa Maria Districts

PURPOSE

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to Decision No. (D.) 10-12-059, dated December 16, 2010, in Application No. 10-01-009, filed January 13, 2010. GSWC is seeking authorization to include in rate base the costs of the completed, operational, used and useful main replacement projects in the Arden Cordova and Santa Maria Districts.

BACKGROUND

These tariffs are submitted as authorized by Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of D. 10-12-059 in GSWC's Application No. 10-01-009. Ordering Paragraph No. 3 states,

3. The disputed construction of 31 pipeline projects in Application 10-01-009, which are not included in the proposed settlement between Golden State Water Company and the Division of Ratepayer Advocates, is adopted for inclusion in rate base and to recover the revenue requirement. For Golden State Water Company to timely recover the revenue requirement of a project it must file a Tier 1 Advice Letter only if it actually builds the project, capped at the forecast cost. Golden State Water Company must file no more than one advice letter per month for the pipeline projects completed and placed in service in the prior month.

Accordingly, GSWC is filing this advice letter to include in rate base and to recover the revenue requirement of the main replacement projects in the Arden Cordova and Santa Maria Districts. These projects were part of the 31 pipeline projects referred to in Ordering Paragraph No. 3 in D.10-12-059.

The authorized project costs cap, the actual costs offset amounts for the projects are summarized as follows:

TIER DESIGNATION

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 3 in D. 10-12-059, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

EFFECTIVE DATE

GSWC is requesting the tariffs contained herein have an effective date of January 1, 2012.

PROTEST AND RESPONSES

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform the Water Division, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with General Order No. 96-B.

2. Service with 5/8 x 3/4-inch meters and 3/4-inch meters is available only to customers served with 5/8 x 3/4-inch and 3/4-inch meters as of May 31, 1995.
3. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in Decision 04-03-039, all bills are subject to a surcredit of \$0.0788 per Ccf for a 9-year amortization period, beginning May 6, 2004 on the effective date of Advice Letter 1150-W. This surcredit will refund the ratepayer portion of the revenues collected from the City of Folsom for the period of July 1, 1994 through March 16, 2004.
4. Pursuant to Decision 05-07-045, to recover the balance as of January 31, 2005 in the Water Quality Litigation Memorandum Account, a surcharge of \$0.155 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for 20 years. The surcharge amount will be recalculated once in every rate cycle, or more frequently if in any year the receipt of Water Availability Fee (WAF) monies will permit a reduction of \$0.50 or more in the monthly bill under Tariff AC-2.
5. Pursuant to Decision No. 10-12-059, a surcharge of \$0.033 per Ccf will be applied to all metered Customer bills excluding customers that are receiving the CARW credit. This surcharge will offset the CARW credits and CARW administrative program costs recorded in the CARW Balancing Account.
6. For the benefit of the customer, GSWC will delay the billing conversion from flat-rate to consumptive rate for one annual seasonal cycle of water use. After one annual seasonal cycle of water use, GSWC will convert the account to consumptive rate during the first billing cycle immediately following the one annual season unless the customer requests an earlier conversion.
7. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, \$0.05462 per Ccf is to be credited to the Quantity Rate for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1433-W. This credit will refund the over collection in the CARW Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2010. CARW customers are exempt from this credit.
8. As authorized by the California Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.01307 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a 12-month period, from the effective date of Advice Letter 1434-W. This surcharge will recover the undercollection in the Supply Expense Balancing Account.
9. As authorized by the California Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.141 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 24-months from the effective date of Advice Letter 1440-W, which is March 8, 2011. This surcharge will recover the under-collection in the WRAM/MCBA Balancing Accounts, for the period January 1 through December 31, 2010.
