CONTRACT FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE
OFF-PEAK POWER

THIS AGREEMENT made this day of,
19....., by and between SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA WATER COMPANY, a California
corporation, hereinafter called the "Company", and
....., hereinafter called the "Customer".

WITNESSETH: That in consideration of the mutual promises herein-
after contained, the said parties do agree as follows:

1. The Company promises and agrees to sell, furnish and deliver to the
Customer and the Customer promises and agrees to purchase and receive from the
Company electric energy in accordance with the rules duly and regularly estab-
lished from time to time by or under authority of law and on file with the
Public Utilities Commission of the State of California and relating to the
furnishing of electric service by the Company.

2. All electric service to be delivered and received pursuant to the
provisions of this contract shall be what is commonly designated as
phase, 60 cycle alternating current and shall be delivered and metered at an
electromotive force of approximately volts, slight variations in
frequency and electromotive force to be allowed.

3. All electric energy to be delivered hereunder shall be used for the
following purposes:

The point of delivery of electric energy hereunder shall be:

The Customer agrees to pay the Company for electric energy delivered
under this contract in accordance with Rate Schedule effective
..... as filed with the Public Utilities Commission of the State
of California. The minimum payments under this contract shall be as per
schedule, but not less in any event than
..... payable

In the event that such schedule is changed, as provided by law, electric energy
supplied after said change is to be paid for in accordance with the altered
schedule.

4. This contract shall be in force during the period of years from and after and thereafter until the Customer shall have instructed the Company in writing to terminate service hereunder.

5. The Customer shall, at the Customer's own risk and expense, furnish, install and keep in good and safe condition all electric lines, machinery and apparatus which may be required for receiving electric energy from the power company or the point of delivery, and the easements and rights of way upon which the same are located, and for applying and utilizing such energy, and will indemnify and save the Company harmless against any and all loss, damage and liability, including, but not limited on all fire fighting cases, expenses, damages and liability to third persons, occasioned or caused by any defect in the condition and construction of such lines, machinery or apparatus, or any part thereof, or the maintenance or care of said easements and rights of way and timber or brush located thereon, or by any forest, brush, grass or any other type of fire that might start thereon or spread thereto or therefrom or by reason of any negligence on the part of the Customer in installing, maintaining, using or operating such lines, machinery or apparatus, easements or rights of way or otherwise.

6. No liability shall attach to the Company for any failure to deliver electric energy hereunder, due to acts of God, or any other causes whatsoever except its own voluntary act or the neglect to exercise reasonable care and diligence in the performance of the covenants herein contained, and the Company shall have the right to suspend temporarily the delivery of electric energy hereunder for the purpose of making repairs or improvements in its system.

7. The Customer agrees not to resell any electric energy furnished under this contract, and this contract shall not be assignable without the prior written consent of the Company.

8. Customer hereby grants to the Company a right of way over the shortest practicable route for any electric service lines which it may be necessary to build over Customer's premises for the purpose of making delivery hereunder.

9. This contract shall at all times be subject to such changes or modifications by the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California as said Commission may, from time to time, direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction.
