Portions of the Cities of Artesia, Bell, Bell Gardens, Carson, Cerritos, Compton, Cudahy, Culver City, Downey, El Segundo, Gardena, Hawaiian Gardens, Hawthorne, Huntington Park, Inglewood, Lakewood, La Mirada, Lawndale, Long Beach, Norwalk, Paramount, Santa Fe Springs, South Gate, and the communities of Athens, Lennox, and Moneta and vicinity, Los Angeles County, and portions of the City of Los Alamitos, Orange County.

The Service Charge is a readiness-to-serve charge applicable to all metered service and to which is added the charge for water used computed at the Quantity Rates.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcredit of \$0.058 per Ccf is to be applied to the Quantity Rate for a period of 24 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1380-W, which is March 21, 2010. This surcredit will recover the overcollection in the MCBA Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2009. (D)
3. Pursuant to Decision 10-11-035, a surcharge of \$0.0056 per Ccf will be applied to all metered customers bills excluding customers that are receiving the CARW credit, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1416-W. This surcharge will offset the CARW credits and CARW administrative program costs recorded in the CARW Balancing Account. (D)
4. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission in D. 10-11-035, an amount of \$0.12933 per Ccf is to be added to the Quantity Rate for a period of 24 months, beginning on January 1, 2011. This surcharge recovers the difference between the interim rates and final rates for the period of January 1, 2010 through December 1, 2010.
5. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a surcredit of \$0.223 per Ccf is to be applied to the Quantity Rate for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1438-WA, which is March 8, 2011. This surcredit will recover the overcollection in the MCBA Balancing Account, for the period of January 1 through December 31, 2010.
